CHAMPAGNE

- 16 **PROSECCO, LUNETTA BRUT** Italy NV £25.00
A fantastic alternative to Champagne. This light and lively Prosecco is perfect as an aperitif and carries a more fashionable audience than Cava at this price level.
- 15 **J.M GREMILLET BRUT** France NV £38.00
Fresh and fruity on the nose with hints of plum, raspberry, brioche and honey. The palate has soft strawberry and raspberry flavours and a lemony finish.
- 17 **POL ROGER, BRUT** France NV £48.00
The wonderful combination of the delicate flowery sweetness of the Pinot Meunier grape and the depth and structure of the Pinot Noir, reveals the breed and elegance of this Grande Marque Champagne.
- 19 **LAURENT-PERRIER ROSÉ** France NV £65.00
This pink champagne needs no introduction...
- 20 **POL ROGER, VINTAGE 1999** France 1999 £95.00
Our top Champagne, what more do we need to say.

HOUSE WINES

- 1 **CATARRATTO, CA'DI PONTI (DRY WHITE)** Italy 2009 £14.25
Vibrant and fresh with a hint of tropical fruit and crisp citrus acidity.
- 24 **NERO D'AVOLA, CA'DI PONTI (SOFT RED)** Italy 2009 £14.25
Juicy black cherry and plum fruit with soft, subtle tannins.
- 3 **LOUIS ALEXANDRE, DEMI-SEC (MEDIUM DRY)** France 2008 £16.00
A medium dry white wine with a refreshing fruitiness that is clean and slightly honeyed, which is balanced by a smooth natural acidity.

RIESLING

- 50 **BERNKASTERLER, LAY RIESLING KABINET, DR LOOSEN** Germany 2007 £26.00
Bright, amazingly fresh fruit flavours, with a dense mineral structure and bracing acidity. This is a vintage of great energy and verve.

PINOT GRIGIO

- 4 **PINOT GRIGIO, BRUME DI MONTE** Pavia, Italy 2009 £17.00
A crisp and refreshing Pinot Grigio, excellent as an aperitif and with light starter dishes. This Italian classic has soft grapey aromas with ripe apple and pear flavours.

SAUVIGNON BLANC AND LOIRE WHITES

- 5 **MUSCADET, CHATEAU LA NOE, SEVRE ET MAINE** Loire, France 2008 £25.00
Fantastic New Vine Muscadet, perfect with seafood dishes.
- 6 **MAKUTU SAUVIGNON BLANC** Marlborough, New Zealand 2008 £19.95
An exciting new addition! Intense ripe citrus and fresh herb aromas, balanced by a tropical fruit character and a lingering finish.
- 8 **LOS TRES CURAS SAUVIGNON BLANC** Central Valley, Chile 2009 £14.95
A fruity bouquet and refreshing flavour with a quality fruity burst.
- 56 **PENCARROW SAUVIGNON BLANC** Martinborough New Zealand 2008 £28.00
Our replacement for the well rated Babich, we loved that but this is even better! Full of intense tropical flavours and a clean lingering finish. Our top recommendation from the Palliser Estate!
- 57 **POUILLY FUME, DOMAINE DES MARINIERS, JOSEPH MELLOT** Loire, France 2008 £25.95
Sauvignon Blanc from the upper Loire valley with a touch more minerality than the average Sancerre. A good choice to accompany fish with a butter sauce.

- 12 **SANCERRE, EXPRESSION-TERROIRS, DOMAINE CHATELAIN, LOIRE** Loire, France 2008 £29.95
Clear, incisive, delicate and fleshy. This wine is simply bursting with citrus, grapefruit and gooseberry.
- 59 **CLOUDY BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC MARLBOROUGH** Marlborough, 2008 £38.00
 New Zealand
Probably the best Sauvignon in the world and yes we've got some!! Overt gooseberry & crisp green apples leap out from this well sought after wine.

CHARDONNAY

- 2 **CHARDONNAY - MACABEO, MONTESIERRA** Somontano, 2009 £15.95
 Spain
Lovely unoaked Chardonnay with exotic fruits and floral aromas, given a little crispness and freshness by the Macabeo.
- 7 **CHARDONNAY CARMEN, MAIPO VALLEY** Maipo Valley, 2008 £19.95
 Chile
A rounded succulent wine with citrus and apple fruit but no wood.
- 11 **CHABLIS, DOMAINE DES MALANDES** Burgundy, 2008 £27.95
 France
Traditional style Chablis with intense green fruit and good minerality, finishing with a hint of honey.
- 61 **CHABLIS 1ER CRU, FOURCHAUME, SEGUINOT-BORDET** Burgundy, 2006 £39.00
 France
A middle weight Chablis with a smokey nose and lingering finish, excellent with fish and shellfish.
- 60 **CORTON – CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU A.C, BONNEAU DE MARTRAY** Burgundy, 2004 £69.95
 France
This wine glistens with a brilliant straw hue and has a distinct bouquet of sweet spice, vanilla and smoky aromas. On the palate this Grand Cru has balanced acids and beautiful structure with flavours of vanilla and smoky oak.

ROSÉ

- 22 **COTES DE PROVENCE, CHATEAU MONTAUD** Provence, 2008 £24.00
France
A delightfully subtle style from this famous region. Light wild summer berry fruits with the merest hint of cream on the finish.
- 23 **PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ, ANCORA** Pavia, Italy 2008 £18.50
The perfect summer tippie, this pink is light, dry and encapsulates the summer mood.

SPANISH REDS

- 26 **GARNACHA, BARSAO** Campo de 2008 £16.95
Borja, Spain
This wine is made on the wind-swept plateau above Rioja from old low-yield vines. Wonderful depth of fruit and not a tough tannin in sight.
- 25 **RIOJA JOVEN, VINA MARRO, BODEGAS DOMECO DE JARAUTA** Rioja, Spain 2008 £19.50
A new style Rioja with lots of plump juicy ripe Tempranillo fruit and no oak.
- 69 **RIOJA PIERRES SELECCION, BODEGAS ANTIGUA USANZA** Rioja, Spain £22.00
Bright summer berry fruits entwine beautifully with vanilla spice and subtle tannins.

BORDEAUX RED GRAPE VARIETIES

- 29 **MERLOT RESERVA, VINA LEYDA** Leyda Valley, 2008 £19.95
Chile
An intensely fruity merlot with soft tannins and a long finish.
- 30 **CABERNET SAUVIGNON/ MERLOT, JORDAN, CHAMELEON, STELLENBOSCH** Stellenbosch, 2006 £29.50
South Africa
A beautifully fresh tasting Bordeaux blend from a top quality South African estate. It's jam packed with ripe juicy blackcurrant fruit.
- 32 **CHATEAU MEAUME, BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR** Bordeaux, 2005 £19.95
France
The Johnson-Hill's have gained a reputation for making an early drinking Claret with an excellent balance and this is no exception!
- 73 **CHATEAU, CAP DE FAUGERES, COTES-DE-CASTILLON** Bordeaux, 2006 £29.00
France
A big fleshy wine made on the border with St Emilion. Exhibiting blackberries, cedar and herbs on the nose and lots of concentration on the palate.

- 33 **ARIDO MALBEC, CARLOS PULENTA** Mendoza, 2008 £18.50
Argentina
Lush blackberry and mulberry fruits with a whiff of spice.

BURGUNDY RED GRAPE VARIETIES

- 68 **PINOT NOIR, EL VIENTO** Central 2008 £24.00
Valley, Chile
A delicate Pinot Noir with vibrant fruit overtones, this wine benefits from the cool El Viento breeze at the foot of the Andes mountains.
- 63 **FLEURIE, VIEILLES VIGNES, POTEL-AVIRON** Beaujolais, 2006 £27.50
France
Sourced from minimum 50 Y.O. Vines this Fleurie has a richness and elegance that elevates it above contemporary wines.

RHONE RED GRAPE VARIETIES

- 27 **SHIRAZ, DRY RIVER** Australia 2009 £16.95
A lush Aussie fruit bomb with a nose of smoky rich fruits with a touch of mint.
- 28 **THE IDIOT SHIRAZ, PHILIP SHAW** Orange, New 2008 £26.95
South Wales,
Australia
Some might say you would be an idiot to miss out on this complex, multidimensional beauty. Being English and more demure than our Antipodean cousins we politely suggest that you indulge yourself with one of the best Shirazes we've tried in a long time.
- 35 **COUDOULET DE BEUCASTEL, COTES DU RHONE ROUGE** Rhone, 2004 £29.00
France
The second wine of Chateauneuf du pape's most famous estate, Chateau de Beaucastel. It is rich, smoky and quite gamey on the nose. On the palate it has plenty of blackberry/cherry fruit and a hint of wild thyme.

ITALIAN REDS

- 65 **CHIANTI, PODERE IL CHIOSTRINO TAVERNELLE DOCG** Tuscany, 2003 £23.00
Italy
Beautifully perfumed with a deep nose of concentrated red cherries. On the palate there is refreshing minerality and spiciness, slightly rustic on the finish but this is typical form from Tavernelle.
